Empty Cages - **Empty cages are NOT to be used as storage space.** If you need to house extra birds, you or the person you are bringing them for will need to rent a sale cage and will be responsible for their care.

Backyard Bird Show

The Backyard Bird Show was created to include hatchery quality birds, non-standard breeds, and mixed breeds. This is a helpful show to enter if you want to share your unique breed with others, are interested in showing but would like guidance on how to get started or even if you are just looking for tips on how you can better prepare your bird for county fairs. A longtime member of the UFPA will judge the backyard show. Awards for the backyard class will consist of Best & Reserve.

Youth Activities

Junior Showmanship -

Inquire at club table Saturday morning for location. No preregistration required. We do not have a dress policy but kids should look neat and tidy. Visit our website for study material and links. Youth up to 17 years old will be divided into classes based on their age. You do not have to exhibit a bird in the show to participate but you must keep the bird in a carrier away from the show cages.

Miscellaneous Activities -

There will be various coloring pages, word search puzzles and other poultry related activities available.

Spring 2025 UFPA Show Rules

1. Entry Deadline is **FEBRUARY 20, 2025**. Please ensure entries are in by this date to allow time to prepare. At the Board's discretion, entries may be accepted until February 25 but will incur a \$1 late registration fee per bird. Please email your entry to utahfancypoultry@gmail.com.
2. **Fees must be paid in full prior to coop-in.**
3. Birds will be accepted in the showroom on Friday from approximately 3 PM to 9 PM and 6:30 AM to 8:00 AM on Saturday.
4. Judging will start at 8:30 AM Saturday.
5. Open show birds will be judged by the latest APA and ABA Standards. Backyard birds will be judged on condition.
6. Make sure you state on your entry form whether entries are LARGE FOWL or BANTAM and whether NON-BEARDED or BEARDED, SINGLE or ROSECOMB.
7. Large Fowl awards will consist of Champion and Reserve Large Fowl, and class champions. Bantam fowl class awards will consist of Champion & Reserve Bantams and class champions. Waterfowl awards will consist of champion and reserve champion. A best and reserve of show will also be chosen. Juniors Awards will be Champion, 1st and 2nd Reserve Large Fowl and Champion and 1st and 2nd Reserve Bantam. Backyard will be Champion and Reserve. At least 5 birds from 2 exhibitors need to be present in a class in order to receive awards.
8. No one will be allowed in the aisles during judging.
9. Cage tags are to be removed ONLY by exhibitors whose birds are in the cage.
10. All birds must have NUMBERED LEG OR WING BANDS. Numbers are not required until coop in. Be sure to write your band number on front and back of coop cards.
11. All birds are entered at the OWNERS' RISK. The UFPA, its officers, or members will not be responsible for any damage, accident, loss, or death of any entry during the show.
12. Any bird showing evidence of disease or sickness will be placed in isolation & returned to owner.
13. No one will be allowed to handle the birds except the judge, show committee, or its owners.
14. Advertising or placing signs on exhibition coops or placing of birds in auction will not be permitted until after judging is completed.
15. Entry forms are provided in the premium and are available on www.utahfancypoultry.com.
16. Coop out will be after the Awards Ceremony on Saturday. NO EXCEPTIONS. We expect that to be around 4:00PM. After, we will be taking down the showroom. Any help is appreciated. If birds are left after coop out they may be boxed up in extra boxes and left for exhibitor to retrieve.
17. All open show entries must be recognized in the latest ABA-APA Standards. All other non standard entries will be judged but will not place better than best of variety.
18. The UFPA will not accept responsibility for birds shipped from out of state.
19. Exhibitors will be responsible for feeding and watering his/her birds. Scratch furnished by IFA.
20. Only pairs and trios will be accepted in the auction. All birds must be of BREEDER or potential SHOW QUALITY.
21. Birds cannot be removed from show building without permission of Show Superintendent.
22. Once birds are entered into cages they cannot be removed from cage except to hand groom or clean birds or pen.
23. No skirting of cages with any material, except clear plastic to prevent fighting.
24. Carrying cages can be stored underneath show cages as long as aisles are kept clean and clear and name of exhibitor or farm is not visible.
25. Parking lot sales are against venue policy and are not allowed.
26. The UFPA does NOT support any illegal actions or inhumane use of poultry.
27. All exhibitors must follow the Deseret Peak Complex rules.

Rosettes for Best Over-All and Reserve Over-All

Premiums are \$15.00 for Best Over-All and \$10.00 for Reserve Over-All
when there are 15 or more entries.

Ribbons to third place.

~~Decorated Eggs~~

Any egg may be decorated in any fashion, if you create a hanging egg, please provide a "hanger" for it, otherwise, we will provide a base for displaying your egg. One Egg per exhibitor, please.

~~Painted or Inked~~

One egg, either Painted or Inked by the exhibitor only. These eggs may be blown or hard boiled.

A free listing plus a Bantam Buck is provided in the upcoming ABA Yearbook for all

Best and Reserve of the seven bantam classes with a minimum of 25.

Star pins will be awarded to all wins in classes of 100 or more.

*All wins in Classes of 100 or more will be denoted with a star * and be retained in the ABA records to accumulate towards the Master Exhibitor, Master Breeder, and Lifetime Achievement awards.*

Only ABA members are eligible to compete for the above awards.

Dues are \$20.00 per year \$50.00 for three years.

New members receive a copy of the quarterly and the latest available copy of the Annual American Bantam Association Year Book which lists many advertisers and includes a complete breed and variety index. Winners of ABA awards are listed in the year book under Who's Who in Bantams.

Starred wins are earned in classes of 100 or more in the following:

- Champions and Reserve Champions in the seven bantam divisions.
- Best and Reserve of Breed and Variety.
- Best Display when 7 or more bantam displays are shown
- Best and Reserve Display when 10 or more bantam displays are shown.
- Best and Reserve Trio when 30 or more trios are shown by 4 or more exhibitors.

A single bird is eligible for only one award and can earn only one starred win.

Want to Request a Breed Club Meet?

If you are a breed club member and are interested in holding a meet at any of our shows, feel free to contact your clubs and include utahfancypoultry@gmail.com on your correspondence. It will be your responsibility to reach out to other exhibitors in your breed to ensure you have enough breed entries. Many clubs have a minimum number of exhibitors and birds needed to consider it a reportable meet and/or to win ribbons awarded by those breed clubs. Be advised, you, or another club member, will be required to bring the club report paperwork with you, fill out your breed club reports at the show, and submit copies to both your club and the UFPA for record-keeping. It sometimes takes extensive follow up with your club to ensure that the reports are properly recorded which you, or the submitting club member, will be accountable for. If you do not have enough exhibitors and choose to not submit a meet report for any given show, please let us know.
